Round 17: Chain 3, *skip 1 stitch, double crochet 2 together, repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the chain 3. (6 dc) 3. Round 18: Chain 3, *double crochet 2 together, repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the chain 3. (3 dc) 4. Round 19: Chain 3, double crochet 2 together, pull the yarn through the remaining 2 loops, fasten off and weave in the ends.

Brim

1. Round 1: Join a new piece of yarn to any stitch around the base of the hat. Chain 3, single crochet into the same stitch. 2. Rounds 2-10: Chain 3, single crochet into each stitch around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the chain 3. (12 sc)

Knobby Buttons (Optional)

To add a touch of embellishment, you can create small knobby buttons to adorn the brim of your hat.

1. Make a magic ring. 2. Chain 3, double crochet 11 times into the ring. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the chain 3. (12 dc) 3. Round 2: Chain 3, *skip 1 stitch, double crochet 2 together, repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the chain 3. (6 dc) 4. Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail. Pull the tail through the remaining loops and tighten to close. Sew the buttons onto the brim of the hat.

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
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
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
