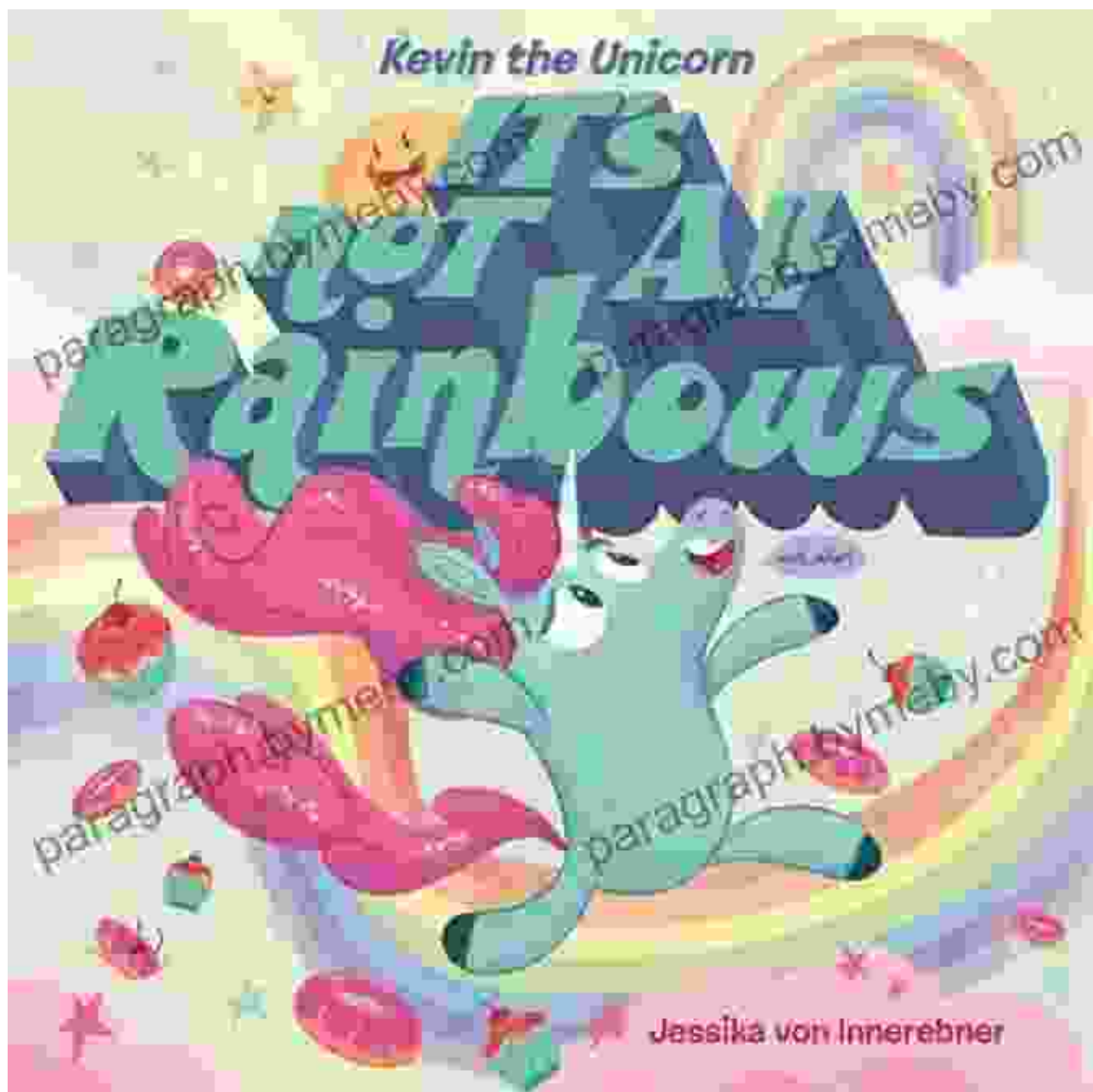


# Kevin the Unicorn: It's Not All Rainbows

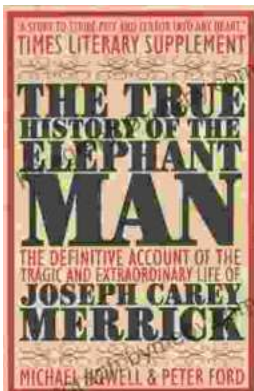

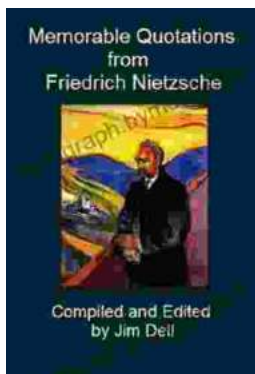
