



Let us return to principle and restore our democracy.



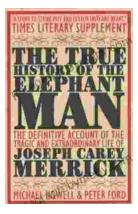
